The month of March will be the end of the earlier opening of the shelter. October through March is the coldest months of the year. All residents do not partake of this early opening but there are always a few. Thank you to all who give their time to homelessness.

THE FOUNDATION DINNERS SPEAKS

Hello, I am Gary Clum, the Agency Director for Foundation Dinners. We at Foundation Dinners are a separate Agency from The Foundation Shelters, but we work closely with the shelter to provide lunch and dinner every day of the year, serving lunch at 12:00 noon and dinner at 4:30. We understand that homeless people especially need a good meal, that their needs are the greatest.

The Foundation Shelters provides a clean, safe place for homeless people and allows them to come out of the weather, find shelter and have Spiritual and moral support. They are encouraged to find jobs. Guidance is given where to find help. When a person is homeless it becomes difficult for them to have much hope and to find encouragement. It can become a viscous cycle of despair. No one wants you because you are homeless with no address when looking for work. And the way that some people look at them and treat them is terrible. The list goes on as to the reason for homelessness.

Jesus calls them, "The least of these My brethren in <u>Matthew 25:40.</u> And the King shall answer and say unto them, "Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me."

Are we helping serve Christ? Or have we ignored who Christ really is and have had no or little compassion for people that are having a difficult time in life?
